Introduction

This document is a principal result of the work of the Georgian Bay Osprey Society. It records the year-to-year results of nest monitoring.

Each year over 60 volunteers monitor nest sites throughout the areas and report on osprey activities at each site. Thus information is collected on which nests were occupied, how many chicks hatched and how many fledged, enabling compilation of [statistics](#) showing the return of the osprey population.

As a result of the Society's work over the years, including erection and maintenance of nest sites (poles), the osprey population has rebounded from an endangered species to a viable state. This represents an important success in the preservation of these interesting raptors.

For each nest site a variety of information is recorded. UTM reference, where present, refers to the grid on Ontario topographical maps NAD84. Location means the latitude and longitude of the nest location and can be used to help find the nest with the aid of a GPS or a chart.
