Introduction

This document is a principal result of the work of the Georgian Bay Osprey Society. It records the year-to-year results of nest monitoring.

Each year over 60 volunteers monitor nest sites throughout the areas and report on osprey activities at each site. Thus information is collected on which nests were occupied, how many chicks hatched and how many fledged, enabling compilation of [statistics](#) showing the return of the osprey population.

As a result of the Society's work over the years, including erection and maintenance of nest sites (poles), the osprey population has rebounded from an endangered species to a viable state. This represents an important success in the preservation of these interesting raptors.

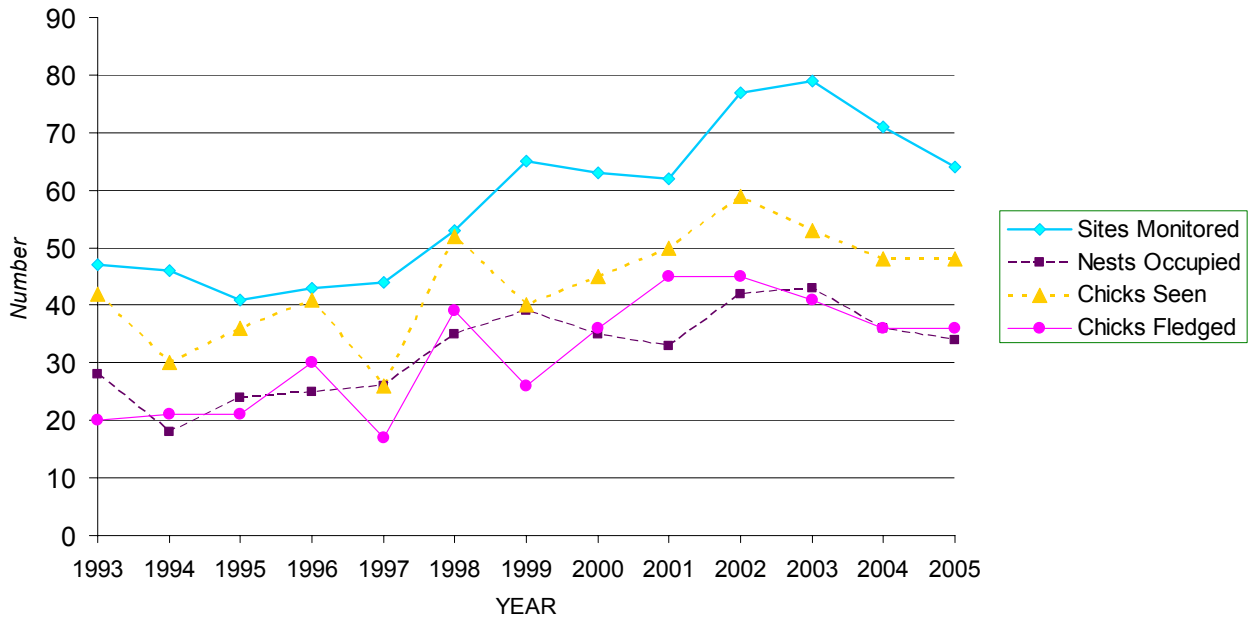

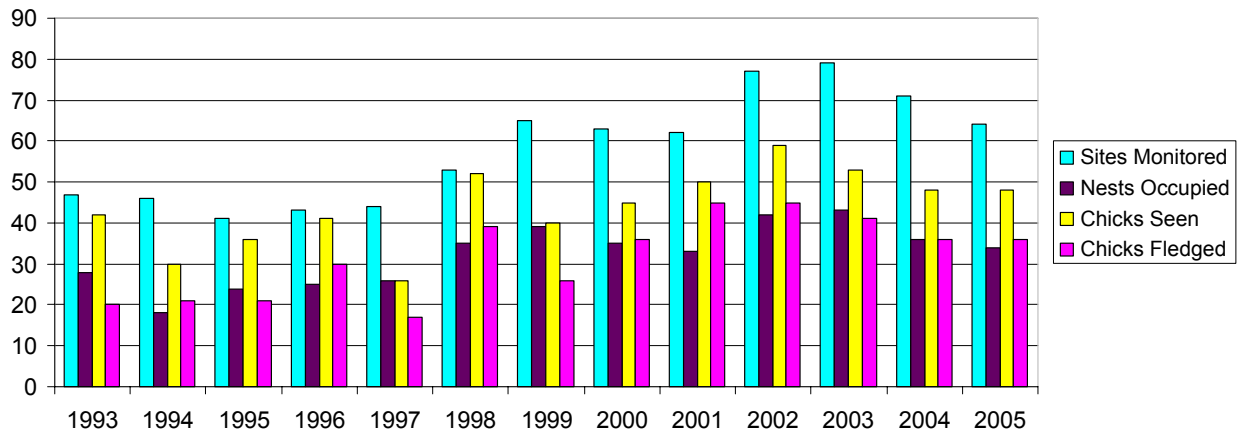
